DEAR TRAVELERS:

Please take the time to read thoroughly the following itinerary as many important details and recommendations about the program are explained here. If you should have any questions or concerns after reading this itinerary, please do not hesitate in contacting one of our travel specialists, we will gladly provide you with further information and make any recommendations to make your trip the most suitable possible.

DAY-BY-DAY TRIP ITINERARY

DAY 1 Arrive at **Baltra Airport** / Transfer to **Isabela Island**

You can arrive to the Galapagos only by flight from either Quito or Guayaquil (air ticket not included). Our English speaking guide will be waiting for you at the airport in **Baltra**, who will then take you to the port of **Puerto Ayora** (Santa Cruz Island) for lunch. Afterwards, we will take the **Public speedboat** to **Isabela Is.** (at 15:00), for approximately two and a half hours. After arriving at Isabela, at the Isabela Island dock, one of our representatives will pick you up to transfer you to the hotel of your choice. On the way to the hotel you will be given instructions for dinner and other activities for the day and the following days.

- DAY 2** Isabela Island:
- OPTION 1:** Hike Sierra Negra + Chico Volcanoes / Snorkel at Concha Perla
 - OPTION 2:** Trekking tour to the Sulphur mines (extra cost – please ask)
 - OPTION 3:** Full Day: Visit Cabo Rosa aka. Tuneles (extra cost – please ask)

(This day you may choose **ONE** of the following options)

OPTION 1: Sierra Negra Volcano + Chico Volcano Hike **PM**. Snorkel in Concha Perla. Early in the morning (8:00 am), after breakfast, you will get ready for the **Sierra Negra Volcano hike** (comfortable clothes, walking shoes and a light rain jacket are recommended). Make sure your camera is stored in waterproof bags, wear some sunscreen, bring water, and a hat! A box lunch will be prepared by yourself at the hotel with the foodstuff of your choice. We will then travel approximately 45 minutes by truck or bus to begin the 12 km hike (appx. 4 hours). The hike is long in terms of distance, but not very difficult as the inclines and declines are quite gradual. **There is an option to ride horses for an additional cost, and if interested please let us know beforehand.**





Sierra Negra Volcano has the second largest crater in the world, measuring approximately 6 miles in diameter and 300 feet deep. We will reach **Chico Volcano** before heading back, which should provide a spectacular view of the incredible moonlike terrain.

Once we get back to the hotel we will take a short break to rest. On the afternoon you will get to do some fine snorkeling in **Concha Perla**. There you can swim with sea lions, colorful varieties of fish, and with luck sea turtles and rays. Return to the hotel to rest before heading to dinner at a local restaurant indicated by the guide.

OPTION 2: Trekking to the Sulfur Mines of the Sierra Negra Volcano (extra cost)

At the specified time, we will pick you up from your hotel on Isabela Island to start this tour of the **sulfur mines**. After a 45-minute drive, we will arrive at our destination, on the outskirts of the Sierra Negra Volcano. We will explore the western side of the Sierra Negra caldera towards the famous sulfur mines of Isabela Island. Once here, we will immerse ourselves in the island's natural beauty with a walk through the Sierra Negra volcano caldera. We will explore different hiking trails leading to the stunning sulfur mines. We will see fields covered with yellow rocks, created by the cooling of gases. We will undertake a 2-kilometer hike, crossing a steep cliff while admiring the cone and its vents. The best part awaits near the entrance to the Sierra Negra crater, with breathtaking panoramic views and the opportunity to witness more sulfur fumaroles. Before concluding the visit to the sulfur mines, we will stop to recharge. We will enjoy a delicious picnic-style box lunch consisting of a sandwich, juice, and fresh fruit. After 4-5 hours, we will return to your hotel on Isabela Island.

After a short rest, we will proceed to try on the snorkeling equipment and head to **Concha Perla**. Here, we can observe a wide variety of fish, sea urchins, the occasional sea lion, and with luck, sea turtles. After a break at the hotel, dinner will be served at the specified restaurant.

OPTION 3: Full Day: Visit Cabo Rosa aka. Tuneles (extra cost)

There are two departure times for this tour, one at 08:00 am with return time at 11:00 am approx. The chosen departure time for your tour might vary; hence, you will be notified on the departure time for this day trip on the night before the tour.

Cabo Rosa aka. Los Tuneles. is perhaps one of the most beautiful sights in the archipelago. Continuous volcanic eruptions petrified into tunnel-like lava formations right in the middle of the sea, and crystal clear turquoise water allows an amazing view of marine vegetation and playful sea lions. The tour begins early at 8:00am via speedboat and the first stop is a small islet in the middle of the ocean, home to pelicans, blue-footed boobies, and sea lions. **Finados** snorkeling site is the next stop, where you can swim next to sea turtles, **Tintoreras** sharks (endemic to the islands), trumpet fish and surgeonfish. With some luck, eagle and golden rays will come to this site too. Getting to Los **Tuneles** will take around 1 ½ - 2 hrs. Once there, the speedboat will navigate through various spots in and around the Lava Tunnels. Here you get the chance to do some more snorkeling and enjoy some short walks while observing the landscape and wildlife inhabiting the area. **A box lunch** on board will be provided for this day. Dinner will be served at the local specified restaurant.

DAY 3 Isabela Island: Kayaks in Puerto Villamil / Humedales Bike Ride

After breakfast and depending on the tide, we will make our way to the dock and prepare for the **kayaking excursion**. After listening to the instructions and safety precautions, and once equipped with lifejackets and oars, you will begin rowing towards **Tintorerías Islet** where you will be able to observe a variety of fauna from our kayaks, including **Penguins, Blue-footed Boobies, and Marine Iguanas**. You will make our way up to **El Faro** before heading back to shore (appx. 2 hours). Return to the hotel for lunch.

In the afternoon we will get ready with our bikes for a ride towards **Humedales Trail Complex**. Our first stop is the **Giant Tortoise Breeding Center** of Isabela. Here we will be able to see a variety of species of giant tortoises in captivity. We will also hear how this center has successfully been able to breed and raise the giant tortoises in order to preserve many of their endangered subspecies. We will mount on our bikes to the **Lava Tunnel**, as well as visits to **Mirador Orchilla, Estero de Isabela, and Playa del Amor**. After parking our bikes and a short hike we will then reach the 100 meters long and 7 meters high **Wall of Tears (Muro de las Lagrimas)**. Between 1946 and 1959 Isabela Island was used as a penal colony by the Ecuadorian government, and the prisoners were obligated to construct this wall out of the sharp and hard volcanic rocks. The name is derived from the arduous work and harsh conditions in which the prisoners work and by which many lost their lives. We will get back on our bikes and return to the hotel to rest before heading to dinner.

DAY 4 Transfer to Santa Cruz Is.: Highlands Hike (Giant Tortoise) / Charles Darwin St.

We will go move on to the Isabela dock (wake-up at 5:00 AM). We will take the **Public speedboat**, which leaves at 6:00 a.m. (subject to change), to Puerto Ayora (2 hour estimated travel time). Once on Puerto Ayora we will have breakfast and take a short rest before making our way to towards the **Highlands of Santa Cruz**. After a car ride we will start our 2 ½ hrs **hike** towards along **Cerro Chato Reserve**. The adventure starts at Santa Rosa through endemic vegetation, rocks, and some mud lagoons. This reserve is the best location to spot **Giant Tortoises**, also known as the **Galapagos**, in their natural environment. We will also check out some incredible lava formations on the way. Galapagos Finches, Bird Wizards will accompany during our hiking adventure. After this incredible encounter with the Giant Tortoises, we will return to Puerto Ayora for lunch.

On the afternoon, we cannot miss the visit to the **Charles Darwin Research Station**. After a short rest, we will meet again with our guide at the indicated hour. Here we will find a variety of Giant Tortoise representing their fellow specie of each island in the archipelago. We will also listen about the ongoing





conservation efforts directed at preserving the Giant Tortoises, as well as the environment of the archipelago as a whole. After this we will make a short visit to the **Art Galleries of Puerto Ayora** and then eat lunch. Return to the hotel to rest before heading to dinner at a local specified restaurant.

DAY 5 Transfer out to **Baltra Airport** - Goodbye Galapagos!

On the final day we recommend waking up at 5:00 a.m. to get ready to get to the dock from there we will take the **Public speedboat**, which leaves at 6:00 a.m. (subject to change), to Puerto Ayora (2 hour and a half estimated navigation time).

After breakfast at Puerto Ayora we then depart for **Baltra Airport** to catch the returning flights to either Quito or Guayaquil. Our unforgettable experience now ends at **Baltra Airport**.

**** NOTE **** Itinerary subject to change without prior warning depending on seasonal changes, weather conditions, and adjustments in policies set by the Galapagos National Park, and other unforeseen circumstances that may arise.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- ❖ **HOTEL SELECTION:** The hotel selection depends on the category of hotel that you choose. Once you choose the hotel class of preference, we will specify to you which hotels are available for the dates of your trip. Hotels are categorized in the following classes: **Standard Class**, **Tourist Superior Class**, and **First Class**. All the hotels we work with have been carefully chosen by us after close inspection.
- ❖ **AIRFARE NOT INCLUDED:** The price of the tour does not include air tickets. We will gladly help you with the booking of the ticket from Quito or Guayaquil to Galapagos. You may also book the flights on your own if cheaper. PLEASE TAKE INTO ACCOUNT which island you will arrive and leave from, and if you choose to book your own flight please try to book your arrival in the morning (before 11 am) and your departure in the afternoon (12 PM or after) so that you don't miss any part of the tour. You can book your flight either through AVIANCA or LATAM (recommended).
- ❖ **RESTAURANTS:** We work with both hotel and local restaurants alike for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. This also depends on the chosen hotel class, as some hotels have restaurant services, **in which case food will be served on the hotel restaurant**. Meals are served in the "meal of the day" style. In case food is not served at the hotel, the guide will specify





the chosen restaurant (**no transfers to and from the restaurants to the hotels are included in the cost of the program. However, distances are all at a minimum walking distance in Galapagos**).

- ❖ **LUNCH AND DINNER** during our tours consist on the meal of the day (not a la carte). Most provisions are bought in form the mainland to Galapagos, hence, a limited variety of food can be found. If you require vegetarian or vegan meals, let us know ahead of time so we can make all arrangements necessary within the possibilities.
- ❖ **GUIDES:** We organize excursion with local naturalist guides for each island (and sometimes for each activity). The guides will accompany you throughout all excursions, give explanations of the islands (flora and fauna) and coordinate the activities each day. Regarding lunch and dinner, the guide will specify the restaurant designated but he will not accompany you during this time. The guide's activities will start and end with each daily excursion. The guide will not go with you on the speedboats between islands either. The guides are certified by the Galapagos National Park - if you feel that their guidance does not meet your expectations, feel free to leave a complaint at the National Park Direction to help improve the quality of service in the islands.
- ❖ **PUBLIC SPEEDBOATS:** We recommend that you take a seasickness pill before each ride between islands if you are prone to seasickness. It is also recommended that you carry small plastic bags with you in case of seasickness. The speedboats are not completely covered so please make sure that valuable objects and electronics are stored in a plastic bag. The **guide will not go with you on the speedboats** but a new guide will greet you on the other side. There are no services onboard as the speedboat space is limited and the journey is relatively short. A water taxi ride is sometimes required (depending on the tide) from the dock to the speedboat; the cost is **1 USD** per person and **per ride**. Please, make sure you bring cash in small denominations in case this expense is needed. ***This is a Public service out of our control.***
- ❖ **SCHEDULE OF EXCURSIONS:** The schedule of the excursions will be coordinated and determined locally through the guide and those responsible for the operations. The guide will indicate what time each activity will start. The transfers between islands on the public speedboats are the only activities that have fixed departure times.

THE RATE INCLUDES:

- ✓ Transportation Baltra Airport – Itabaca Channel - **USD 5,00 per person** (subject to change).
- ✓ Transportation Itabaca Channel – Baltra Airport - **USD 5,00 per person** (subject to change)

- Isabela and Santa Cruz Dock Fee - USD \$12.00.

- Extra cost for alternative excursion on Day 2 (OPTION 2 or 3)
- Water taxi from dock to speedboat (Isabela and Santa Cruz Islands - depending on the tide) - **\$ 1.00 US per person per ride**
- Cost of the transfer between the hotels and the restaurants designated for the meals in each island
