





DAY-BY-DAY TRIP ITINERARY

DEAR TRAVELER:

Please take the time to read thoroughly the following itinerary as many important details and recommendations about the program are explained here. If you should have any questions or concerns after reading this itinerary, please do not hesitate in contacting one of our travel specialists, we will gladly provide you with further information and make any recommendations to make your trip the most suitable possible.

Day 1 Arrive at San Cristobal Airport / – Visit Interpretation Center & Cerro Tijeretas

You can arrive to the Galapagos only by flight from either Quito or Guayaquil (air ticket not included). Our guide will be waiting for you at the airport on San Cristobal Island. From the airport you will be taken to the hotel to check in to your rooms and leave your bags. After a rest in the hotel - visit the San Cristobal Interpretation Centre where our guide will explain how the Galapagos Islands were formed, the evolution of species, the migration of the animals, and the human settlements within the Galapagos.

After visiting the Interpretation Center, we will make our way to “Cerro Tijeretas”, or “Frigate Hill”. Here we can encounter marine animals and also do some snorkelling to see colourful fish species, starfish, sea urchins, or to simply enjoy the crystal clear waters. The afternoon continues with a visit to Playa Carola, where you will have time to enjoy the beautiful beach before returning to the hotel. **The guide will leave you at the Dive Center to try on your diving gear and hear some instructions for the first diving the next day. Overnight.**

Day 2 FULL DAY DIVING KICKER ROCKS (2 immersions)

This diving site in San Cristobal Island is located at approx. 1 hour from San Cristobal by marine transportation (speed boats). These spots are very famous for scuba diving and snorkeling activities. Diving trips include a “check dive” and two immersions in the designated areas (diving sites are fixed daily and depend on availability), the first one in the morning and the second one prior to the return. A box lunch will be served board after the first diving. Diving day-trips will also include a short hike to a

nearby beach for relaxing and wildlife viewing. Average hour of return to Puerto Baquerizo is at 16:00 pm.

Day 3 Transfer to **Santa Cruz Is.** – Free Morning / Visit Highlands (Giant Tortoise Center)

At 6:00 a.m. get ready to go to the dock (wake-up at 5:00 AM). We will take the Public speedboat, which leaves at 7:00 a.m. (subject to change), to Puerto Ayora (2 hour estimated travel time). Upon arrival the guide will take us to eat breakfast, after which you will have the morning free to relax. After lunch (not included in the cost of the trip), take a short rest before making our way to the Highlands of Santa Cruz. Here we will have the amazing opportunity to observe the famous Giant Tortoises in their natural environment, which also known as Galapagos, it is from that the Islands get their name. We will also be able to see the famous Galapagos Finches, Bird Wizards, as well as endemic vegetation such as Escelacias forests and Matazarnos. After this close encounter with the Giant Tortoises, return to the hotel to rest before heading to the Scuba Diving center where you will also try on your diving gear for next days. Overnight.

Day 4 **FULL DAY DIVING EXCURSION (2 immersions)**


After breakfast, meet at **Scuba Dive Center** at 7:00AM or the hour established the day before. You will hear some last instructions before departing via sea and land to the diving site. After a weight check you will go for the **first immersion** (20 - 25 m deep). Day 5 **FULL DAY DIVING EXCURSION (2 immersions)**

Day 6

FULL DAY DIVING EXCURSION (2 immersions)

After breakfast, meet at the **Scuba Dive Center** at 7:00AM or the hour established the day before. You will hear some last instructions before departing via sea and land to the diving site. After a weight check you will go for the **first immersion** (20 - 25 m deep). A surface interval for one hour is scheduled to have snack-lunch and enough energy for the **second immersion** (depth 15 -23 m). We will have a snack before returning to Puerto Ayora around 16:30pm to the hotel.

Day 7

FREE DAY or guided day trip: Option 1 or 2 (extra cost)

In your last day you can either choose a **FREE DAY** or ask us to arrange for a guided visit to Charles Darwin Station in the morning and Tortuga Bay in the afternoon or a navigable tour, for an extra cost.

Option 1: In the Charles Darwin Research Station you will find a large variety of tortoise's species coming from each island on the archipelago. You can also listen about the ongoing conservation efforts directed at preserving the Giant Tortoises, as well as the environment of the archipelago as a whole. The afternoon hike to Tortuga Bay beach could be the perfect ending to your trip. Abundant wildlife inhabits the place and the view is astounding as it is considered one of the most beautiful beaches in Galapagos.

Option 2: A full-day navigable tour. The destination can be **Santa Fe, South Plazas, North Seymour or Bartolomé Island**. The activities will include hiking, snorkeling, swimming and breathtaking sightseeing. After land and sea excursions, we will return back to the hotel in Santa Cruz.

**** Note **** If you choose either Option 1 or 2, **please let us know before booking your trip**. This way we can arrange and check availability in order to arrange your itinerary in the best way possible.

Day 8 Transfer out Baltra Airport - Goodbye Galapagos!

After breakfast, the guide will pick you up to guide you to Baltra airport so you can catch your flight back to the mainland to either Quito or Guayaquil.

**** NOTE **** *Itinerary and diving sites are subject to change without prior warning depending on seasonal changes, weather conditions, and adjustments in policies set by the Galapagos National Park, and other unforeseen circumstances that may arise.*

IMPORTANT REMARKS:

- ❖ **HOTEL SELECTION:** The hotel selection depends on the category of hotel that you choose. Once you choose the hotel class of preference, we will specify to you which hotels are available for the dates of your trip. Hotels are categorized in the following classes: **Standard Class, Tourist Superior Class, and First Class.** All the hotels we work with have been carefully chosen by us after close inspection.
- ❖ **AIRFARE NOT INCLUDED:** The price of the tour does not include air tickets. We will gladly help your with the booking of the ticket from Quito or Guayaquil to Galapagos. You may also book the flights on your own if cheaper. PLEASE TAKE INTO ACCOUNT which island you will arrive and leave from, and if you choose to book your own flight please try to book your arrival in the morning (before 11 am) and your departure in the afternoon (12 PM or after) so that you don't miss any part of the tour. You can book your flight either through AVIANCA or LATAM (recommended).
- ❖ **RESTAURANTS:** We work with both hotel and local restaurants alike for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. This also depends on the chosen hotel class, as some hotels have restaurant services, **in which case food will be served on the hotel restaurant.** Meals are served in the "meal of the day" style. In case food is not served at the hotel, the guide will specify the chosen restaurant (**no transfers to and from the restaurants to the hotels are included in the cost of the program. However, distances are all at a minimum walking distance in Galapagos.**)

- ❖ **LUNCH AND DINNER** during our tours consist on the meal of the day (not a la carte). Most provisions are bought in form the mainland to Galapagos, hence, a limited variety of food can be found. If you require vegetarian or vegan meals, let us know ahead of time so we can make all arrangements necessary within the possibilities.
- ❖ **GUIDES:** We organize excursion with local naturalist guides for each island (and sometimes for each activity). The guides will accompany you throughout all excursions, give explanations of the islands (flora and fauna) and coordinate the activities each day. Regarding lunch and dinner, the guide will specify the restaurant designated but he will not accompany you during this time. The guide's activities will start and end with each daily excursion. The guide will not go with you on the speedboats between islands either. The guides are certified by the Galapagos National Park - if you feel that their guidance does not meet your expectations, feel free to leave a complaint at the National Park Direction to help improve the quality of service in the islands.
- ❖ **PUBLIC SPEEDBOATS:** We recommend that you take a seasickness pill before each ride between islands if you are prone to seasickness. It is also recommended that you carry small plastic bags with you in case of seasickness. The speedboats are not completely covered so please make sure that valuable objects and electronics are stored in a plastic bag. The **guide will not go with you on the speedboats** but a new guide will greet you on the other side. There are no services onboard as the speedboat space is limited and the journey is relatively short. A water taxi ride is sometimes required (depending on the tide) from the dock to the speedboat; the cost is **1 USD** per person and **per ride**. Please, make sure you bring cash in small denominations in case this expense is needed. ***This is a public service out of our control.***
- ❖ **SCHEDULE OF EXCURSIONS:** The schedule of the excursions will be coordinated and determined locally through the guide and those responsible for the operations. The guide will indicate what time each activity will start. The transfers between islands on the public speedboats are the only activities that have fixed departure times.

PRERREQUISITES TO PARTICIPATE

- It is mandatory to hold a diver's certification (PADI, NAUI, CMAS, etc).
- Complete the application form
- Medical Certificate if declaring any medical condition and/or people over 60 years old that have not been diving during the last 8 months.
- Minimum age to participate 11 ages.
- We accept certified beginner divers at all dive sites except Gordon Rocks for which we require a minimum of 25 logged dives or the previous dive evaluation of our dive guides, while diving at another site.
- For divers who are not certified, we offer the Discover Scuba Diving and PADI diving courses (Ask for the program).
